Readings: Isaiah 63:16-17, 64:1,3-8 Psalm 79 1 Corinthians 1:3-9 Gospel Mark 13:33-57

Reflection for this Sunday ...

In Advent, Christians relive a dual impulse of the spirit: on the one hand, they raise their eyes towards the final destination of their pilgrimage through history, which is the glorious return of the Lord Jesus; on the other, remembering with emotion his birth in Bethlehem, they kneel before the Crib. The hope of Christians is turned to the future but remains firmly rooted in an event of the past. In the fullness of time, the Son of God was born of the Virgin Mary: 'Born of a woman, born under the law', as the Apostle Paul writes (Ga 4:4). We might say that Advent is the season in which Christians must rekindle in their hearts the hope that they will be able with God's help to renew the world.

SAINTS FOR THE WEEK

Monday Saint John Damascene, Priest, Doctor of the Church

St John Damascene was born in Damascus in the late seventh century. He was a monk and priest at the monastery of St Sabbas in Jerusalem. He is remembered for defending the faith and for his devotion to Our Lady. He died in 749.

Tuesday Feast of Saint Birinus, Bishop

St Birinus was sent to England by Pope Honorius I, was ordained as a bishop and established his See at Dorchester on Thames. He died in 650.

Wednesday Saint Nicholas, Bishop

(Fourth century) St Nicholas was born perhaps at Patara (now in Turkey) and became bishop of Myra he was imprisoned under the Emperor Diocletian and had attended the Council of Nicea which opposed the Arian Heresy. The saint's relics were later brought to Bari (Italy).

Thursday Saint Ambrose, Bishop, Doctor of the Church

St Ambrose was born in Trier about 340. While still preparing for his own Baptism, he was chosen to be bishop of Milan. It was on this day in 374 that he was ordained bishop. He died in 397.

Friday Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary Patroness of the Archdiocese of Birmingham.
Saturday Saint Juan Diego Cuauhtlatoatzin

(1474-1548) St Juan Diego was born near what is now Mexico City and converted to Christianity in middle age. He showed a great piety and walked many miles to attend Holy Mass. While doing so on 9 December 1531, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to him on Mount Tepeyac, asking that a shrine be built on the spot. The local bishop asked for a sign and Our Lady left a miraculous portrait of herself on St Juan Diego's tilma or mantle.

UN Climate Conference (COP28)

This is a vitally important conference the results of which affect us all. Pope Francis was intending to go but, 'with regret' has cancelled his visit on health grounds. He wrote in Laudate Deum that 'only a process of this sort can enable international politics to recover its credibility, since only in this concrete manner will it be possible to reduce significantly carbon dioxide levels and to prevent ever greater evils over time'. Please pray not just for the Pope's health but also that countries at COP28 will live up to his urgent call for greater ambition on addressing the climate crisis, and for politicians to leave a legacy they can be proud of.

Cafod/Laudato Si Group

In Britain every Christmas we throw away 226,800 miles of wrapping paper. There is no need to throw it away. It can re-used many times. And you can buy wrapping paper made from hemp, or from recycled paper. How about using attractive and re-usable cloth material instead of paper? Use ribbon instead of tape for sealing, so that the paper can be more easily re-used or recycled. The ribbon can be re-used as well, as can the bows. All of these actions will help the environment and contribute to reducing our carbon footprint.
