SAINTS FOR THIS WEEK ...

Monday Feast of the Baptism of the Lord

Friday Saint Aelred of Rievaulx. Abbot

(1109-1167) St Aelred was born in Hexham and joined the Cistercian monastery of Rievaulx, and became known as a preacher and a writer, the 'Bernard of the North'. He delighted in friendship and wrote, 'he who dwells in friendship, dwells in God and God in him.'

Saturday Saint Hilary, Bishop, Doctor of the Church or of Our Lady on Saturday

(315-368) Born at Poitiers, St Hilary was brought up a pagan and married young. He later converted to Christianity and, as Bishop of Poitiers, was a leading defender of the Church against the Arian heresy, which caused him to be exiled to Phrygia by the Arian Emperor, Constantinus. He was declared a Doctor of the Church in 1851.
