Reflection for Fifth Sunday of Easter

The Gospel this Sunday, the Fifth of Easter, proposes a twofold commandment of faith: to believe in God and to believe in Jesus. In fact, the Lord said to his disciples: 'Believe in God, believe also in me' (Jn 14:1). They are not two separate acts but one single act of faith, full adherence to salvation wrought by God the Father through his Only-begotten Son. The New Testament puts an end to the Father's invisibility. God has shown his face, as Jesus' answer to the Apostle Philip confirms: 'He who has seen me has seen the Father' (Jn 14-9). With his Incarnation, death and Proversed in the Son of Cod has freed us from the slavery of cin to give us the freedom of the child

Resurrection, the Son of God has freed us from the slavery of sin to give us the freedom of the children of God and he has shown us the face of God, which is love: God can be seen, he is visible in Christ.

Saints for the week ...

Tuesday Day of Prayer for the Survivors of Sexual Abuse

Wednesday Saint John of Avila, Priest, Doctor of the Church

John was born in Almodovar del Campo in Spain, around 1500. As a priest he travelled throughout Andalusia, drawing crowds by his preaching. His enemies, disturbed by his success and challenged by his teaching, denounced him for heresy, and he made no attempt to avoid imprisonment or trial, but preached the Catholic faith even more fervently. He played an important part in the setting up of the Council of Trent, where his voice was heard through the treatises he wrote for its guidance, even though he was not well enough to attend. He spent his last years in Montilla, and there he fell asleep in the Lord on 10 May 1569.

Friday Saints Nereus and Achilleus, Martyrs or of Saint Pancras, Martyr

Ss Nereus and Achilleus were Roman soldiers during the reign of Diocletian. They embraced the true faith. As a result, they were martyred. (+304) Barely fourteen years old, St Pancras was martyred during the reign of Diocletian. According to tradition he preferred rather to die than renounce his faith in Christ. He was buried on the Via Aurelia where Pope Symmachus built a basilica over his tomb.

Saturday Our Lady of Fatima

The blessed Virgin Mary appeared to three shepherd children at Fatima (Portugal) on the thirteenth day for six consecutive months in 1917. She brought a message of peace and reparation for sin, encouraging devotion to her Immaculate Heart and the recitation of the Holy Rosary.


