#### **SAINTS FOR THE WEEK**

#### **Tuesday** Feast of Saint Benedict, Abbot, Patron of Europe, Day of Prayer for Europe

(480-547) St Benedict was born at Norcia, Italy, and was sent to Rome to be educated. He chose to live a solitary life at Subiaco and eventually organised a form of monastic life in twelve monasteries. The monks who joined St Benedict devoted themselves to work and prayer. In the great abbey on Monte Cassino, which he founded, he wrote his Rule in which are wonderfully combined the Roman genius and the monastic wisdom of the Christian East. He was proclaimed Patron of Europe by Pope St Paul VI because of his wonderful influence in the formation of Christendom in the Middle Ages.

#### Thursday Saint Henry

(973-1024) Henry II, Duke of Bavaria, was corowned Emperor in 1014. He used his power to extend the kintgdom of god by promoting missionary work.

#### Friday Saint Camillus de Lellis, Priest

(1550-1614) St Camillus de Lellis came from a noble family of Chieti, Italy and was a young soldier of fortune when he decided to consecrate his life to the service of the sick. He improved the treatment and care of hospital patients. He founded the Order of Hospitallers which carries his name.

#### Saturday Saint Bonaventure, Bishop, Doctor of the Church

(1218-1276) St Bonaventure was born in Italy. He entered the Franciscan Order. At thre University of Paris, where he was a lecturer, he met St Thomas Aquinas. He became the General of the Franciscan Order and a Cardinal. Known as the 'Seraphic Doctor', he is considered the greatest exponent of mystical theology in the Middle Ages.

#### CAFOD urges government to protect the right of farmers to use their own seeds

Next weekend there will be an opportunity to add your signature to those of Archbishop Bernard and our local area Bishop, David Evans to a letter calling on the World Bank to stop making life very difficult for farmers in developing countries. They are increasingly being prevented from using their own seeds. For generations, small scale farmers have freely swapped and shared a wide variety of seeds to produce food and maintain biodiversity. They have developed seeds that ensure crops are resilient to climate change. However, their right

to choose what seeds they use is under threat as new laws, supported by the World Bank and the IMF, are introduced that limit what they can do with their seeds, making life even more difficult for them. Salina, a small scale farmer from Bangladesh, has written a letter to the World Bank and with CAFOD's help is asking Catholics here to support her by adding their signatures. The bishops have already signed, (see parish Facebook page) and passed it to the parish for us to add our signatures. Please take a moment after Mass next weekend to sign.
