# Reflection for this Sunday ...

'God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life.' We hear these marvellous words in today's Gospel. The first thing to note is that it is God who took the initiative in our salvation. God chose the approach of love, not of power. God acts not for his own sake but for our sake. God is not an absolute ruler who is not happy until he has reduced his subjects to abject obedience. Rather, God is the Father who is not happy until all his wandering children have come home. God's love is all-inclusive. His love is not directed at one nation only, nor is it only for the good. It is directed at all nations, to the children of light and to the children of darkness.




### PRAYER FOR PEACE IN THE UKRAINE & MIDDLE EAST

#### Act now to stop DIY abortion up to birth

Diana Johnson MP has tabled an amendment (New Clause 1) to the Government's Criminal Justice Bill, which is coming up for Report stage in Parliament in early March. This amendment seeks to change criminal law so that 'no offence is committed by a woman acting in relation to her own pregnancy' at any gestation. This means that a woman who included her abortion at home using pills (or any other method) at any stage of pregnancy, including just before natural birth, would commit no offence. This is dangerous for women and lethal for unborn babies. Please contact you MP urgently, asking them to oppose this extreme and barbaric proposal. You can do this using SPUC's easy to use webtool, at https://www.spuc.org.uk/abortion amendments. Please pray for the defeat of this amendment, for protection of unborn babies, and help and comfort for mothers in need.

#### **Fairtrade Sale**

This takes place at the back of church next weekend after all Masses. As well as chocolate bars and some foodstuffs it includes the Real Easter Egg. This is the only one available promoting the true meaning of Easter, sales help others both here (food banks) and overseas through the fairtrade premium. It is not available in supermarkets. Dark Chocolate £5.50, Milk Chocolate £4.50 (both 150gm)

#### **Redditch Food Bank**

Thank you for the continued donations for the Foodbank, demand for their services is still high so the support of the Parish is having a real impact on people's lives. They still have a high priority for the following items:

Long Life Milk, Jams and Spreads, Rice 1kg bags, Pasta Sauce, Tinned Meats (Curry, minced beef and steak) - **PLEASE NO FRESH PRODUCE OR SUGAR.** 

#### **Chrism Mass**

This takes place every Maundy Thursday at St Chad's Cathedral and includes the blessing of the anointing oils to be used throughout the diocese for the following year. As part of it's aspiration to become a fairtrade diocese it now uses Zaytoun olive oil, a fairly traded Palestinian oil. Small bottles of these, (250 ml) will be available at next week's Easter fairtrade sale after all Masses. Price £8.80 (20% below normal price).
