Saints for the Week ...

Tuesday

Saint Henry

(973-1024) Henry II, Duke of Bavaria, was crowned Emperor in 1014. He used his power to extend the kingdom of God by promoting missionary work.

Wednesday

Saint Carmillus de Lellis, Priest

(1550-1614) St Camillus de Lellis came from a noble family of Chieti, Italy, Camillus was a young soldier of fortune when he decided to consecrate his life to the service of the sick. He improved the treatment and care of hospital patients. He founded the Order of Hospitallers which carried his name.

Thursday

Saint Bonaventure, Bishop, Doctor of the Church

(1218-1274) St Bonaventure was born in Italy. He entered the Franciscan Order. At the University of Paris where he was a lecturer, he met St Thomas Aquinas. He became the General of the Franciscan Order and a Cardinal. Known as the 'Seraphic Doctor', he is considered the greatest exponent of mystical theology in the Middle Ages.

Saint Kenelm, Prince of Mercia

(821) St Kenelm was said to have been a Mercian prince, who at the age of seven succeeded to the throne of his father, King Kenulph. He was murdered in the forest of Clent by order of his sister, Cyndefrith. In medieval England he was universally venerated as a saint and martyr.
