Saints for the week ...

Tuesday Saint Cyril, Monk & Saint Methodius, Bishop, Patrons of Europe

(+ 869) (+885) These two brothers evangelised Moravia, Bohemia and Bulgaria. They translated liturgical books into Slavonic with the help of the Cyrillic alphabet which they invented. St Cyril died in Rome where ha had gone to seek the Pope's blessing. Methodius was consecrated bishop by Adrian II and ended his days in Pannonia (Hungary). Pope St John Paul II proclaimed them patron saints of Europe, along with St Benedict, abbot.

Friday Seven Founders of the Order of Servants of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Seven members of a Florentine confraternity founded the Order of Servites of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Servites led an austere life of prayer and mortification, meditating constantly on the Passion of the Lord and venerating the Blessed Virgin Mary as Our Lady of Sorrows.
