Reflection for this Sunday ...

In the two readings we are dealing with a unique and specific call, what is more commonly called a vocation. Samuel is being called to the role of prophet, and Andrew and the others to discipleship. The initiative is always with God. The 'call' is always his. And every call demands a response. Great events often begin very simply. This was how Jesus began his mission. He looked for a little band of kindred souls, and demanded total commitment from them. And got it. God calls us too, in many ways and at many different levels. He called us into life. Throughout our lives God continues to call us to a life worthy of our dignity as his children. At death God will call us from this life into eternal life.

SAINTS FOR THIS WEEK ...

Wednesday Saint Anthony, Abbot

(251-356) Called the 'Patriarch of Monks', St Anthony retired to the desert when he was eighteen years old. He was the first abbot to form a stable rule for his family of monks dedicated to the Divine Service. He led an austere life which was always consciously directed to the better service of God.

Friday Feast of Saint Wulstan, Bishop

(1008-1095) St Wulstan became a Benedictine monk at Worcester and, after serving, a Precentor and Prior, was appointed as Bishop in 1062. He was the only Englishmen to retain his See after the Norman Conquest. His wise and benevolent rule lasted thirty-two years, during which he rebuilt his cathedral, reformed the diocese and tried to stop the slave trade at Bristol. (English slaves were sold to Norse traders in Ireland until the twelfth century)

Saturday Saint Fabian, Pope, Martyr or of Saint Sebastian, Martyr or of Our Lady on Saturday

(+240) St Fabian was Pope from 236 to 250 AD. He promoted the consolidation and development of the Church. He divided Rome into seven diaconates for the purposes of extending aid to the poor. The papacy acquired such prestige during this time that he incurred the ire of the Emperor Decius.

(+300) St Sebastian, a native of Milan, was an officer in Diocletian's imperial guard. He became a Christian and suffered martyrdom upon the orders of the emperor. His tomb on the Via Appia (Rome) was soon visited by pilgrims.
