Keflection for this Gunday ...

What a poor world it would be if everyone put their own personal safety, security, and selfish advancement first and last—if no one was prepared to go beyond themselves. It is always because people have been prepared to die to self-interest that the most precious things humanity possesses have been born. Jesus gave us an example. He gave his life in the service of his heavenly Father and of us. But he didn't find it easy. When the actual moment of death arrived, he was filled with fear. Jesus' life wasn't taken from him. He gave it—gave it out of love of God and of us. To love is to accept that one might die another kind of death, before one dies one's own. The way of love is the way of the cross, but the way of the cross leads to the resurrection. Those who die to self will find the

SAINTS FOR THIS WEEK

Monday Saint Cyril of Jerusalem, Bishop, Doctor of the Church

(c315-386) St Cyril was born near Jerusalem and for many years served as Patriarch of that holy city, although after disputes with Arian heretics, they had him exiled for seventeen years. He is mainly known for his 'Catecheses'. His instructions, which are still present, show conclusively that catholic doctrine is the same then as now. It was his catechetical instructions which led him to be declared a Doctor of the Church in 1882.

Tuesday Solemnity of Saint Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary Saturday Saint Turibius of Mongrovejo, Bishop

(1538-1606) St Turibius was born in |Mayorga (Spain) and worked for many years as a professor of law at Salamanca. In 1580, even though still a layman, he was appointed Archbishop of Lima (Peru), where, after being ordained, he did much to consolidate ecclesiastical discipline and champion the rights of indigenous people.

Act now to stop DIY abortion up to birth

Diana Johnson MP has tabled an amendment (New Clause 1) to the Government's Criminal Justice Bill, which is coming up for Report stage in Parliament in early March. This amendment seeks to change criminal law so that 'no offence is committed by a woman acting in relation to her own pregnancy' at any gestation. This means that a woman who included her abortion at home using pills (or any other method) at any stage of pregnancy, including just before natural birth, would commit no offence. This is dangerous for women and lethal for unborn babies. Please contact you MP urgently, asking them to oppose this extreme and barbaric proposal. Please pray for the defeat of this amendment, for protection of unborn babies, and help and comfort for mothers in need.
