

Reflection for Seventh Sunday of Easter

In his farewell discourses to the disciples, Jesus stressed the importance of his 'return to the Father', the culmination of his whole mission: indeed, he came into the world to bring man back to God, not on the ideal level—like a philosopher or a master of wisdom—but really, like a shepherd who wants lead his sheep back to the fold. It was for our sake that he came down from Heaven and for our sake that he ascended to it, after making himself in all things like men, humbling himself even to death on a cross and after having touched the abyss of the greatest distance from God. For this very reason the Father was pleased with him and 'highly exalted' him (Ph 2:9), restoring to him the fullness of his glory, but now with our humanity. God in man—man in God: this is even now a reality, not a theoretical truth.

Saints for the week ...

Monday Saint Rita of Cascia, Religious

(1381-1457) St Rita of Cascia was born near Spoleto and, despite wanting to enter religious life, spent nearly twenty-two years in a difficult marriage. After the deaths of her husband and her two sons, she joined the Augustinian House in Cascia, Umbria. She is known as the 'saint of the impossible'.

Thursday Saint Bede the Venerable, Priest, Doctor of the Church

(673-735) St Bede was born in England. As a Benedictine Monk, he was, 'the most observant and the happiest of all monks.' His writings were full of sound doctrine, so he was called 'Venerable' while still alive. He wrote commentaries on Holy Scripture and treatises on theology and history. He died at Jarrow, England.

Friday Saint Philip Neri, Priest

(1515-1595) St Philip Neri was born in Florence, Italy, he was ordained a priest in 1551 and founded the congregation of the Oratory. He is noted for his zeal in converting sinners through the Sacrament of Penance. He was a catechist and a spiritual guide of extraordinary talent. He died at eighty years of age.

Saturday Feast of Saint Augustine of Canterbury, Bishop

(+605) St Augustine was sent by St Gregory the Great to England to convert the English people to ?Christianity. He baptised King Ethelbert of Kent and many of his subjects. At Canterbury, he erected a monastery and there established his Episcopal See..
