#### SAINTS FOR THE WEEK

#### Thursday Feast of Saint Andrew, Apostle

(First century) St Andrew was born at Bethsaida and worked as a fisherman. He is called the Protokletos or 'first called', for he was originally a disciple of St John the Baptist before following Christ and bring with him his brother, St Peter. After Pentecost he zealously preached the gospel and was crucified at Patras, Greece. He is the patron of Scotland, where his relics were formerly venerated at St Andrews.

#### Friday Feast of Saint Edmund Campion, Priest, Martyr

(1540-1581) St Edmund Campion was born in London and educated at Christ's Hospital school. He was a brilliant student at Oxford. Reconciled to the Catholic Church, he passed on to Douai and then to Rome where he joined the Jesuits. Next, he worked in Bohemia, and finally for one year, on the English Mission. His extraordinary success caused him to hunted down relentlessly. He was martyred at Tyburn. Saturday Our Lady on Saturday
