Reflection for this Gunday ...

On this Fifth Sunday of Easter, the liturgy presents us with the Gospel passage of John in which Jesus, speaking to the disciples at the Last Supper, exhorts them to remain united to him like the branches to the vine. It is a truly meaningful parable as it expresses with great effectiveness that Christian life is a mystery of communion with Jesus: 'Whoever remains in me', says the Lord, 'will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing' (In 15:5). The secret of spiritual fruitfulness is union with God, union that is realised especially in the Eucharist, also rightly called 'Communion'.

SAINTS FOR THIS WEEK

Monday Saint Catherine of Siena, Virgin, Doctor of the Church, Patron of Europe

(1346-1380) St Catherine was a responsible instrument for the return of Pope Gregory XI from Avignon to Rome. In deed and in truth, she showed her love for God's Church and the Roman Pontiff. With her short life she gave us a lesson in courage: the courage of telling the truth for love of the Church and souls. Imprinted with the sacred stigmata, she died in Rome at thirty-three years of age. She was proclaimed patroness of Italy on 18 June 1939. In 1970, Pope Saint Paul VI proclaimed her Doctor of the Church.

Wednesday Saint Joseph the Worker

Thursday Saint Athanasius, Bishop, Doctor of the Church

(295-373) St Athanasius, Bishop of Alexandria, Egypt, became the champion of the fight against Arianism at the Council of Nicea. He suffered persecution and was exiled for seventeen years for resisting compromise in essentials of the Faith. He wrote many works on apologetics.

Friday Feast of Saints Philip and James, Apostles

Like St Peter and St Andrew, St Philip was from Bethsaida. He was crucified at Hierapolis in Phrygia, where he had preached the Gospel. He introduced St Bartholomew to Christ. Christ declared to St Philip, 'He that hath seen me, hath seen the Father I am in the Father and the Father in me' (John 14: 8-9)

Saturday Feast of the English Martyrs

This feast celebrates the many men and women who suffered for the Faith in England between 1535 and 1680 and have subsequently been recognised by the Church. These included priests, both secular and religious, as well as laity who were prepared to shelter them, to arrange secret Masses, and to witness the Faith. They came from all ages and backgrounds, and their heroic witness helps us have a greater love for the Church, the Mass and the Priesthood.
