SAINTS FOR THIS WEEK

Thursday Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord Holyday of Obligation

Friday Saint John of Avila, Priest, Doctor of the Church

John was born in Almodóvar del Campo, in Spain, around 1500. As a priest he travelled throughout Andalusia, drawing crowds by his preaching. His enemies, disturbed by his success and challenged by his teaching, denounced him for heresy, and he made no attempt to avoid imprisonment or trial, but preached the Catholic faith even more fervently. He played an important part in the setting up of the Council of Trent, where his voice was heard through the treatises he wrote for its guidance, even though he was not well enough to attend. He spent his last years in Montilla, and there he fell asleep in the Lord on 10 May 1569.
