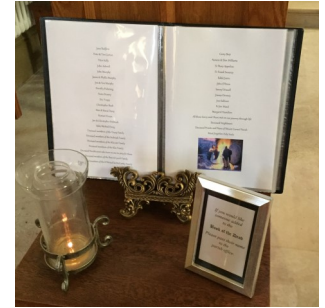
## NOVEMBER—MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS

### Saints for the week ...

**Monday Saint Willibrord, Bishop**

*St Willibrord was born in Yorkshire. He preached the gospel in present day Germany and was renowned as a great missionary. He suffered many trials but overcame them with a joyful spirit. He died in the year 739.*

**Tuesday Blessed George Napier, Priest, Martyr (Oxfordshire)**

*Blessed George Napier was born in Oxford and educated at Douai. He ministered as a priest for seven years before his martyrdom in Oxford in 1610.*

**Wednesday Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica**

*The Archbasilica of the Most Holy Saviour, St John the Baptist, and St John the Evangelist (commonly known as the Saint John Lateran) is the Cathedral Church of Rome and therefore is the first in rank in the Catholic world. Hence its dedication day is observed as a Feast of the Lord.*

**Thursday Saint Leo the Great, Pope, Doctor of the Church**

*St Leo was born in Tuscany. He became pope in the year 440 and is remembered for defending the unity of the Church and preserving the teachings of the Church from error. He died in the year 461 having defended the city of Rome from attack by the barbarians.*

**Friday Saint Martin of Tours, Bishop**

*St Martin was born in present day Hungary about the year 316. He gave up his military career, was baptised and became a disciple of St Hilary of Poitiers. He became the bishop of Tours, France. He died in the year 397. He was the first non-martyr with an annual feast day in the church's calendar. He is a patron saint of priests.*

**Saturday Saint Josaphat, Bishop, Martyr**

*St Josaphat was born in the Ukraine, of an Orthodox family about the year 1580. He became a Catholic though continued to celebrate the Liturgy in the Byzantine Rite. As Archbishop of Polock he worked to unite the Church. He was martyred in 1623.*
